

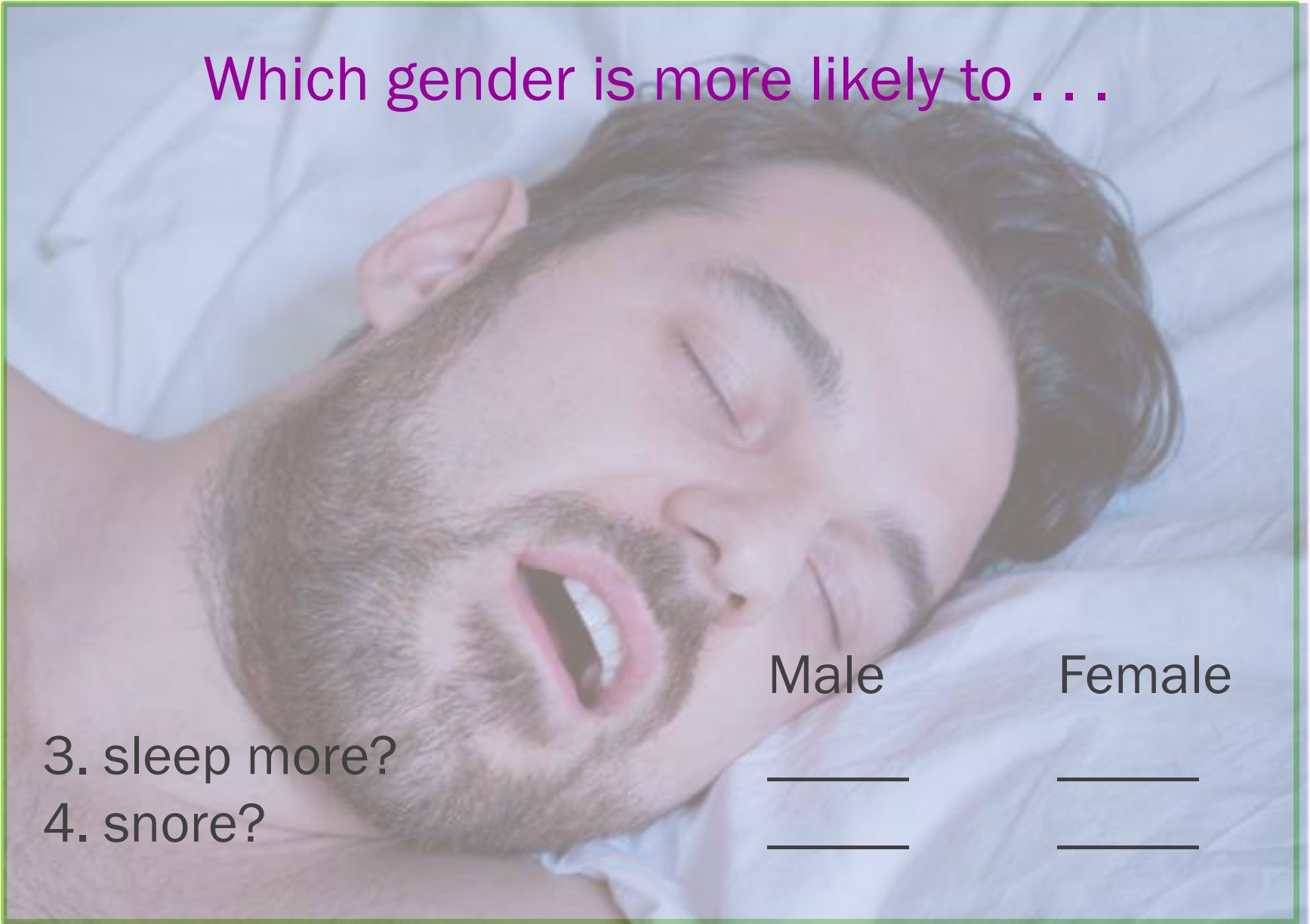

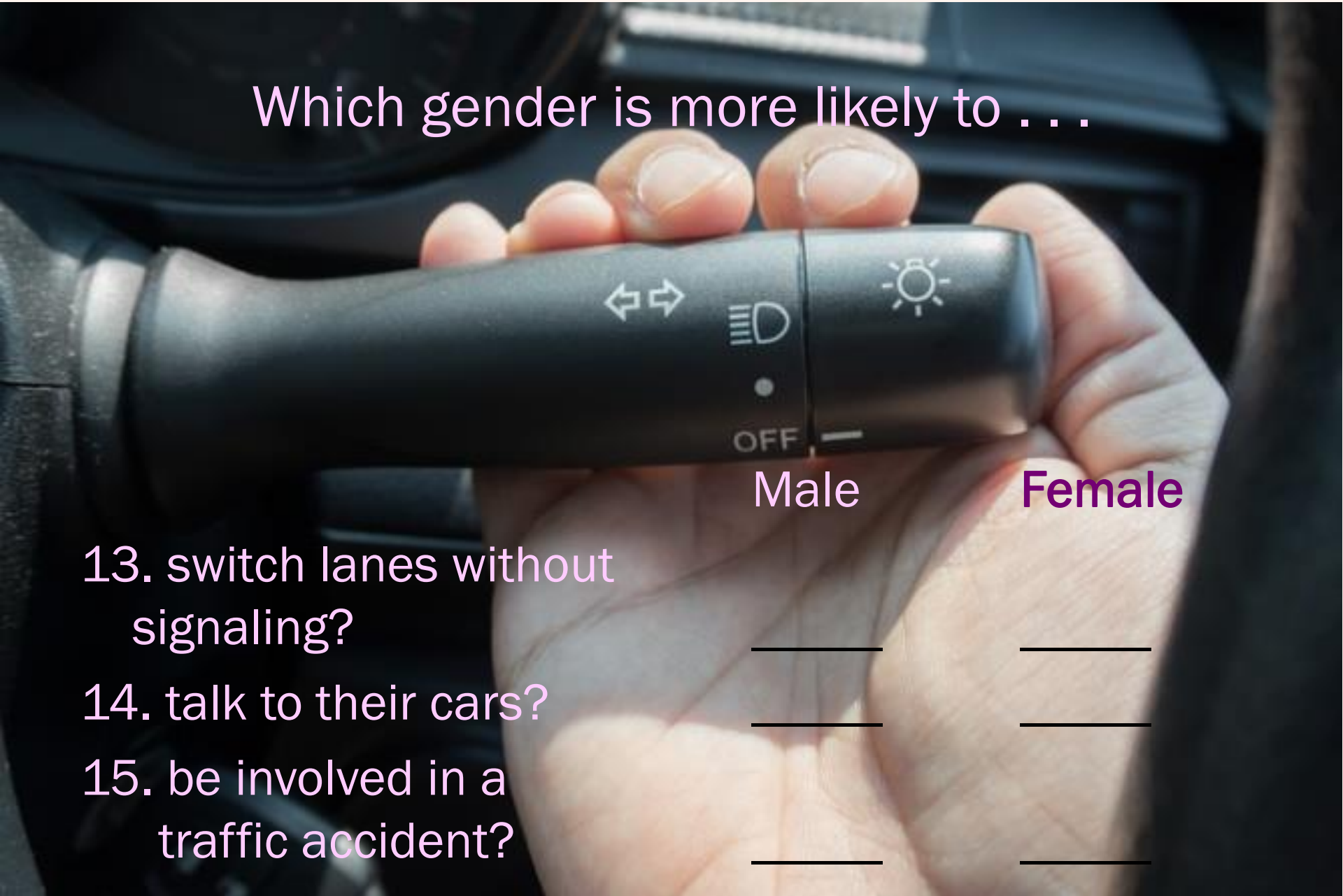
Explanation

Quiz to discussion

Let the quiz questions lead to discussions: Research says women laugh more than men and seek a good sense of humor in personal ads more than men – and men tend to advertise that characteristic more than women. What's your reaction to that?

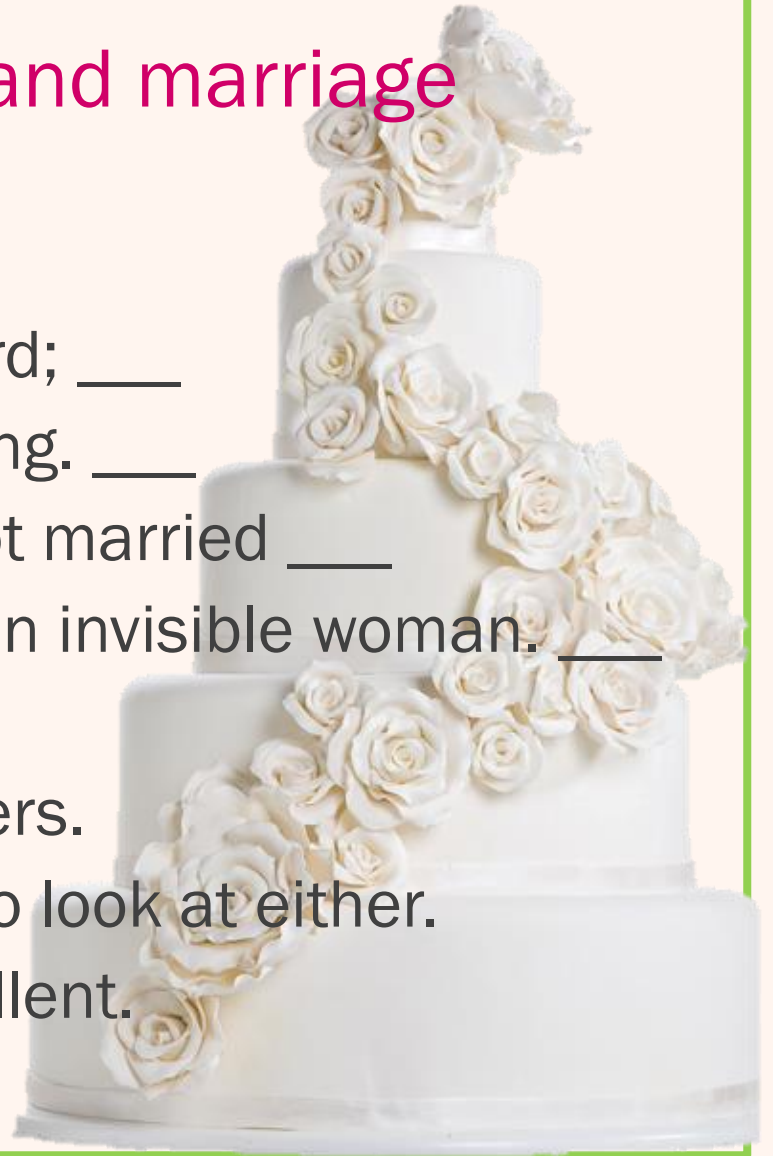
- In your view, who has the better overall sense of humor (not just joke-telling ability): men or women? Why do you think so?

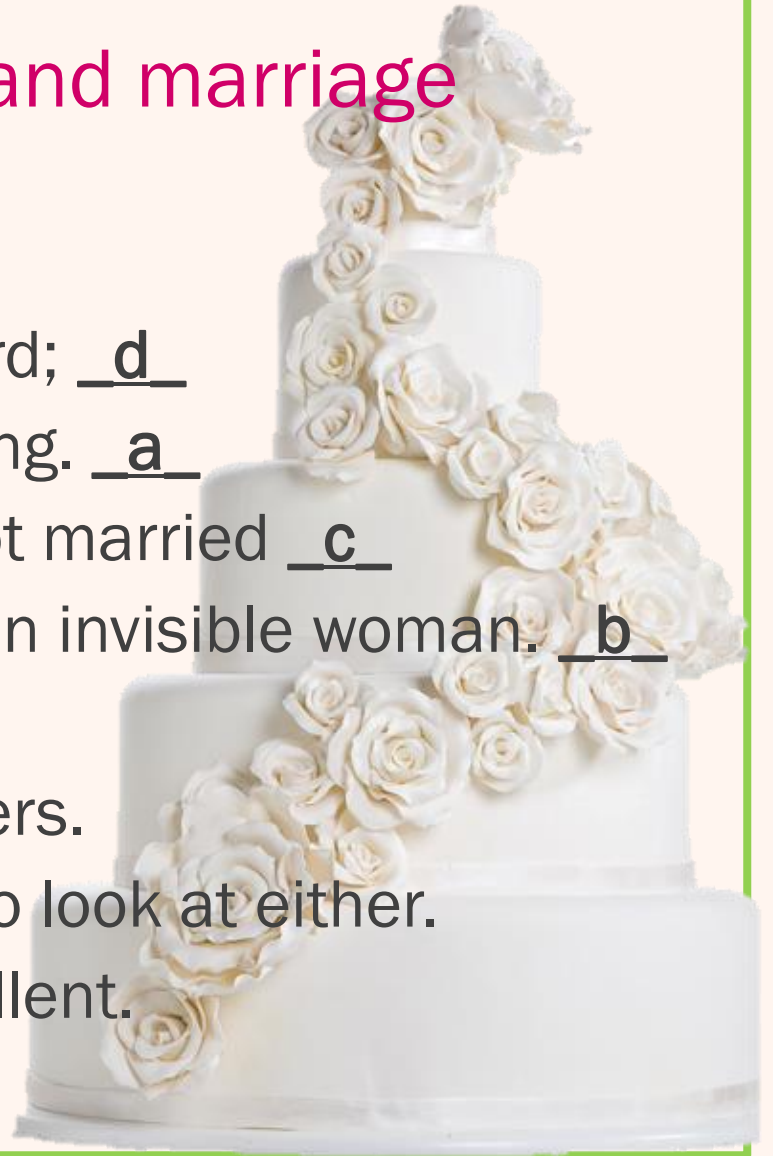
