Rock 'n' Roll Dice Game

Gather up some rocks and play a game of Rock 'n' Roll. If you place your rock on the right number, you win.



Number of Players

Can be played in small or large groups.

Setup

- Die and cup for shaking
- Rock 'n' Roll Game Strips, one strip per player (See reverse.)
- Small rocks that will fit on the game strips, one per player
- Paper and pencil for keeping score

The object of the game is to be the player with the highest score at the end of the game.

To Play

1. Give each player a game strip and a rock.
2. Ask players to place their rock on one of the numbers on the strip.
3. Roll the die. Players who have a rock on the matching number get one point.
4. Play up to 20 rounds. The player with the most points at the end of play is the winner.

Variations

- Give players 20 chips that can be used to bet on a roll. Players must bet at least one chip, but they may bet as many chips as they want. For example, the player might place their rock and three chips on the number 5. If the roll is a 5, the player gets one point and also three more chips. If the roll is not a 5, the player loses the three chips. Play 10 rounds. The winner is the person with the most chips at the end of the game.
 - For easier games, use two dice. Players get a point if their rock is on one of the two numbers on the dice.
